**The Eucharistic Standard (Fr. Jarrod Lies):** "One of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked him." (Lk 17:16) Even as the word Eucharist means thanksgiving, gratitude is the necessary response to gift. Gratitude is like harvesting a field: one can only gather the grain one notices; what is not notices cannot be harvested. Gratitude is the ability to recognize goodness and appreciate it. It trains the heart to recognize abundance before scarcity, and providence before complaint. Gratitude, then, is its own gift. It deepens the steward's interior response to God's generosity.
